Above the hanukia and the rainbowcolored stripe is the inscription "One

light." Avi explains, "Basically, everything is one big light." As we know, bringing light into the darkness is a prime theme of the popular celebration of Hanuka. Other elements in the art-

work include a hand holding a platter of steaming latkes; and a dreidel and gelt, in the lower left.

At Heilicher, Avi enjoys gym, art and Judaic studies. As far as hobbies, he collects rocks, especially agates, picked up along the North Shore of Lake Superior or purchased in rock shops. He also takes piano classes and goes mountain biking.
